

In 2022, the Foundation has:

- Engaged and empowered young people through the UC HYPE group (Helping Young People Engage) by the way of networking, learning and connecting with opportunities. The first EPIC night was memorable!
- Secured out-of-county grant funding for several projects: the library expansion, utility infrastructure expansion, College Corner playground project, LES preschool program and more!
- Continued working on the downtown property development. We completed feasibility studies, master plan study and are ready to engage investors
- Awarded 68 grants and 44 scholarships
- Said "goodbye" and "welcome" to departing and new board members and team members
- Implemented a large operating software change which encompassed the financial/accounting platform as well as a new online scholarship process
- Completed many trainings and professional development courses as Foundation team and beyond
- Added 2 new funds to our fund family of 110!
- Promoted Union County community in the larger region and entire state
- Funded a welcoming mural on the building as well as other community beautification efforts
- Raised \$383,771 in donations that support goodwill efforts in our community – contributed directly to Foundation funds as well as local nonprofit organizations
- Convened community networking meetings that encourage collaboration and partnerships

2022 Year in Review



2022 was an exciting year for Union County and it has been a privilege to serve as the Special Projects Coordinator. In this role I have had the opportunity to serve the community in many capacities which include representing Union County in the Southeast Indiana Region for READI (Regional Economic Acceleration and Development Initiative), assisting the UC Nature Park as they begin fundraising efforts, hosting an economic development forum to help develop a comprehensive economic development strategy for our Central Indiana region, as well as being a helping hand throughout the community as

needed. These are all such exciting projects and bring light to the many great things on the horizon for our community. One project that I am so proud of is the new playground at the Grove in College Corner. This project, and how it came to fruition, truly shows the essence of my role as the Special Projects Coordinator. West College Corner's Town Council had a dream of updating the playground at the Grove to an urban style. With their vision, I was able to hit the ground running looking for grants and fundraising opportunities to make this vision become a reality. Between the Council's investment, the community's positive response to the crowd funding campaign, the Indiana Housing and Community Development Authority's grant, the Union County Foundation grant, the Lilly Lead Forward grant, and a very generous legacy gift from late Bonnie Raisch, we were able to invest over \$203,000 into this playground which will serve families in our community for a long time. This would not have happened if the community had not worked together and it truly shows what an impact we can have when we are all playing for the same team—the **Union County team!**

Scholarships


Help eager individuals reach their educational goals.


